The District is continuing its street valve maintenance program that includes checking valve caps, exercising the valves, and clearing out debris from the valve stems. The District's Operation Team has completed maintenance on 250 of the District's 360 street valves. Keeping the water main valve boxes free of debris and making sure that the street valves are operational enables the Operations Team to shut off water mains quickly in the event of a water main break.

Landscape Irrigation

As the weather warms up, the District's residents will begin to irrigate their landscaping. The District wants to remind you that it has a Water Demand Management Strategy in place to help it meet the increased water demands



that come with landscape irrigation. The District requests that residential and commercial landscape irrigation be limited to three days a week based on your street address as follows:

- Odd-numbered street addresses: Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday
- Even-numbered street addresses: Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday

Additionally, the District's Rules and Regulations states, "Irrigation systems, either manual or automatic, shall only be operated during off-peak energy usage periods (10:00 p.m. through 10:00 a.m.)."

The Eagle Development Company is continuing its site grading for Paint Brush Hills Filings 13B, 13C, and 13D along Londonderry Drive west of Towner Avenue. The utilities infrastructure construction is scheduled to begin by the end of May 2017. The final phase of the infrastructure construction will be completed in September 2017 according to Jeff Mark, president of The Landhuis Company which owns Eagle Development Company. A total of 253 residential lots will be developed within the three filings.

Representatives of Falcon School District 49 have informed the District that the site grading for the Londonderry Elementary School (north of Falcon Middle School) will begin in June 2017. The water and sanitary sewer tie-in to the District's mains will start later in the same month.
