On Saturday, October 7, 2017, the District's Board of Directors conducted a ribbon cutting at the recently constructed gazebo in South Manchester Park, officially dedicating it to the residents of the District. The gazebo was constructed by Copestone General Contractors, Inc. at a cost of \$55,785, below the \$58,181 the Board had budgeted for it. The cost of the gazebo was funded by the District's Conservation Trust Fund which is funded by the District's share of distributions from the Colorado State Lottery.

Flushing these types of items down the toilet causes home pipes to clog, wastes water (up to 5 gallons of water every time you flush) and most importantly can have a huge impact on our sewers and not to mention our waterways.

Below is a list of items that people commonly flush that should not be going down the toilet. Sanitary Products, Paper Towels, Diapers, Baby Wipes and Facial Tissuesare made of materials that don't break down and can cause all pipes to clog. The trash is the place for these items.
