

Gazebo to be Built in South Manchester Park

### **Funded with State Lottery Proceeds**

At its January 19, 2017 meeting, the Board of Directors approved the plan to construct a gazebo in South Manchester Park. It also accepted a proposal from Copestone General Contractors to construct the gazebo for an amount not to exceed \$56,765. The twenty-

New trees will be planted, the walking paths will be extended, new rock will be added to the existing paths, and the mulch will be replaced. The District's Team will participate in four Teambuilding workshops to be facilitated by Laura Benjamin with Communicate Colorado during 2017. The District's \$12,000

If your water bill suddenly increases, but you haven't changed the way you use water, chances are you've sprung a leak. If you can not identify visible leaks, **read your water meter**. <u>*Read*</u> <u>more</u>.

### **Be Ready for Freezing Temperatures**



The American Red Cross has some suggestions to prevent your pipes from freezing Winter, along with its freezing temperatures, will be here before we know it. There are some steps you can take to prevent the pipes in your home from freezing. Check out the American Red Cross website on <u>Preventing and Thawing Frozen Pipes</u>.

The District will respond to a call from a resident whose neighbor's home shows signs of a water leak due to frozen pipes. If a leak is confirmed by District staff and there is no one home, the water service to the property will be shut off at the curb stop. This will result in a \$25 charge to the property owner for the shut off and an additional \$25 charge to restore water service.
